Hello, everyone. Today I'd like to tell you about the contest held last week. Even now I can't believe I got \*the first prize. In this contest, I told people about the way to \*revitalize our town. I \*presented my idea about making a new food by using scallops, a \*local specialty here. Scallop means hotate in Japanese.

To get ready for my idea, I thought about what the famous things were in our town. We can see the beautiful \*sunrise over the sea. On every New Year's Day, a lot of people from other towns come to see it. Next, our town is famous for a large \*catch of scallops. \*Fishers have caught and sent them all over Japan. Carrots from our town are also famous. My mother cooks good food with these carrots.

I found that there're good things here, and decided to use scallops and carrots together to make something new. After thinking of that for a few days, I decided to make special \*buns with \*the following features. \*Cooked scallops are put in the bun. Carrot is \*mixed into the \*dough to (1) the color of the bun orange like the sunrise. I \*named the bun "Hotate-Sun." The word "Sun" is from the sunrise.

I also made  $_{\oplus}$  a \*character to make the bun more \*attractive. Its face is a scallop with two eyes and a mouth. It raises both hands, and has a cap on its head.

After getting these ideas, I decided to present them in the contest.

In the contest, I explained how I got the idea of "Hotate-Sun" and showed the character to the people there. I told that I really love our town and want it to become more famous.

After finishing presenting my ideas, I got \*comments from the \*judges. First, a woman said, "The food is very interesting. If it becomes true, I think many people living in other towns would like to eat "Hotate-Sun," and our town will be more popular.

I also think the fishers will become happy when they (who / think / scallops / about / the people / eat) from our town." Next, a man said, "Making a new local specialty is a useful way to introduce our town to people. I'd like to put your cute character on the town's \*web page. I also (2) our town as much as you do. So I'm really happy to know how you feel about our town." I was excited to hear that.

Through this experience, I looked at our town more than before and found that it has many good things. Learning more about our town is important to show it to people. I'll keep trying to find what I can do for our town.
